

BRADFORD W. & BRONSON W. MANSFIELD BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

1. The candidate must be a graduate from a local public or private high school in Lenawee County.
2. The candidate must be entering either his/her junior, senior, or 5th year at a public or private college or university in Michigan, majoring in business.
3. The candidate must possess superior scholastic achievement (represented by a college grade point average of 2.5 or better).
4. Demonstrate business and entrepreneur qualities and interest.
5. Demonstrate high character qualities.
6. Demonstrate an interest and ability of helping others.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

1. The scholarship will be for one year in length.
2. The amount of the scholarship may vary from year to year, but is expected to be approximately \$750-\$1,000 per award, per year.
3. The scholarship will be paid jointly to the student and the institution, with one-half payment being made each semester, providing the student continues his/her formal education into the second semester.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applications and statements must be typed and signed in all instances.
2. Official high school and college transcripts are required from the beginning of the 9th grade up to the due date of the application. Transcripts may be photocopied provided the school authorizes it.
3. College admission test scores are required to be attached and also may be photocopied.
4. The applicant shall include a typewritten essay of 300 words (maximum) in length addressing business and entrepreneurship through the question, "As a business major, I ..."
5. Two letters of recommendation from individuals who have been seriously involved with the applicant in the past two-four years.
6. The application should be prepared and arranged in the following order:
 - a. Completed and signed application
 - b. Essay (see #4)
 - c. High school and college transcripts
 - d. College admission test scores (ACT)
 - e. Two letters of recommendation
6. Deadline for submitting the application is the second Friday in March.
