

Lucy Wolcott Barnum Chapter DAR Scholarship Award

HISTORY

The Lucy Wolcott Barnum Chapter is a combined chapter, which includes Abi Evans Chapter from Tecumseh and is the only Daughters of the American Revolution chapter in Lenawee County. Our organization is comprised of women whose ancestors participated in the American Revolution 1775 to 1783.

The goal of the DAR is: "To preserve Constitutional government of the people, by the people, for the people and to instill in the hearts of all Americans a sense of Patriotic pride in our forefathers who - at so great a cost - left us a heritage of freedom."

AWARD

Three \$1,000 scholarships are awarded to graduating female seniors who will attend a post-secondary institution. These awards will be paid to the student and the school.

DEADLINES

The completed application must be filled out and turned in by the second Friday in March. Included within must be a copy of your high school transcript and at least one letter of recommendation.

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REQUIREMENTS:

1. Graduating Senior from a Lenawee County High School.
2. Female Student.
3. Attend a 2 or 4 year college.
4. Must show financial need.
5. Student with a B (3.0) grade or better.
