

THE FLEUR-DE-LIS SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

1. The candidate must be a graduating senior who has applied to an accredited degree/certificate granting institute of higher education (2 or 4 year college or university, trade or technical school).
 2. The candidate must have a minimum accumulated GPA of 2.5.
 3. The candidate must be able to attend an interview with the Scholarship Committee (as required).
 4. The candidate must be an active member in a Lenape District Boy Scout Unit (including Cub Scout leader and/or Explorer post member). Note: The applicant is **not** required to be an Eagle Scout.
 5. Financial need is not a consideration for this scholarship.
- Obtain three (3) letters of recommendation:
 1. Unit Leader describing applicant's involvement in the Unit.
 2. Two (2) other letters from non-family members to attest to the non-scout activities of the applicant.
 - The applicant must write an essay 350-500 words in length outlining their scouting experiences and describing how scouting has better prepared them for the future.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Application and statements must be typewritten, signed, and dated.
2. Attach official high school transcripts from the beginning of the 9th grade up to the due date of the application. Transcripts may be photocopied with the authorization of the school.
3. College admission test scores (ACT) are to be attached if applicable and may be photocopied.
4. The applicant shall prepare a typewritten essay which is 350-500 words in length. The essay will outline his/her scouting experiences and describe how scouting has better prepared him/her for the future.
5. Three letters of recommendation: One from your Unit Leader and two non-family members to attest to the non-scout activities of the applicant.
6. The application should be prepared and arranged in the following order:
 - a. Completed and signed application
 - b. Essay (see #4)
 - c. Letters of recommendation (see #5)
 - d. Transcripts
 - e. College admission test scores (ACT)
7. Deadline for submitting application is the second Friday in March.
