3-D Digital Design

Students will use 3-D graphics software to produce 3-D models and animations. This course will introduce students to 2-D and 3-D modeling, animation planning, storyboard development, the creation and application of textures, mapping, lighting, camera, and animation of 3-D models. Students interested in learning more about careers as an animator, industrial designer, 3-D modeler, or technical director should take this summer course.

Business Math

Students interested in business-related careers and consumer applications will find this course useful. Topics will include the mathematics of business operations and record keeping, banking, purchasing, and sales. Situations involving discounts, commissions, interest, taxes, and depreciation will be studied. Students will be involved in learning how to communicate information mathematically, solve problems from a real-world context, and justify the solutions to problems.

Collision Repair and Refinish

In this course students will learn the process used to restore damaged vehicles. Specific areas include: creating estimates of repair costs; welding torn metal; priming and painting metal; and meeting customer expectations.

Consumer Math

This course is for students who are interested in a course designed to develop and reinforce the applications of mathematics in today's society. Students will investigate topics such as money management, banking, filing tax forms, budgeting expenses, calculating net pay, buying and renting a home, and finding the operating cost of a motor vehicle. The goal of this course is to guide students in building a strong foundation in logical thinking and problem solving that will enable them to make good decisions in their daily lives.

Early Childhood Development – Preschool

This course is for students interested in becoming an elementary or preschool teacher, owning a day care, or studying child psychology. This summer course will prepare students for future entry into many phases of child care employment. Students will practice a variety of skills related to the physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development of young children.
