LISD Adult Transition Support Services

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WHO: Post-Secondary students with an IEP that have not received a high school diploma. Transition needs should be addressed by the IEP team and be addressed as part of the transition plan.

WHERE: Housed at the LISD South Campus house located at 1354 North Main Street. The driveway just south of the TECH Center (used to be the United Way).

HOW: If you have a student that you feel may benefit from ATSS, *first* have a conversation with your special education supervisor. If deemed necessary, please invite ATSS staff to attend transition planning meeting.

WHAT: Programming is individualized and based on a students' post school outcomes and goals. The transition planning team will facilitate a schedule of experiences based on need. Current student need has programming based on volunteerism, daily living skills, recreation and community involvement.
